MRC's Mission: Midcoast Recreation Center, a nonprofit organization, is committed to the promotion of healthy living in our community through sports and fitness programs.

Program Goal:

We follow the American Development Model (ADM) station based practices that are designed for Long Term Athlete Development (LTAD). Our goal is for our kids to find joy in the game and set a great foundation for their future success on and off the ice.

Schedule:

We have scheduled a 20 week season starting on October 4th not including a few weeks off at Thanksgiving and Christmas time as we believe it's important to spend time with family and to get some breaks. Practices will be Monday and Friday at either 4:30-5:20pm or 5:30-6:20pm.

Cost:

Cost is \$225 for the full season. A deposit of \$75 must be made to register and a payment plan is required this year due to uncertainty and ease of reimbursement should cancellations occur. \$75 includes the first month's deposit and each month through March is \$30/month. Please note that all of our programs are eligible for financial assistance and one of our guiding principles is that we do not turn anyone away regardless of their ability to pay.

Registration Deadline:

September 14th is the Registration Deadline. Any registrations after this date will be subject to a \$50 surcharge. Space will be limited.
