The situation surrounding COVID-19 is constantly evolving and MRC will reevaluate when to open on a week-to-week basis. Some specific items moving forward

- MRC's programs, tennis contracts, open Pickleball play, and tennis court rentals are suspended
- Fitness memberships and exercise programs are suspended
- MRC is honoring previously booked private lessons. This only includes lessons during the day from 8am-5pm. (This still is acceptable under CDC guidelines)
- All ice skating programs including the ice show has been canceled
- This week the ice will be removed for the season
- Refunds will be given out on a prorated basis (please consider a donation or system credit as MRC goes through this difficult financial crisis)
- MRC will be working on a plan to reopen as quickly as possible
